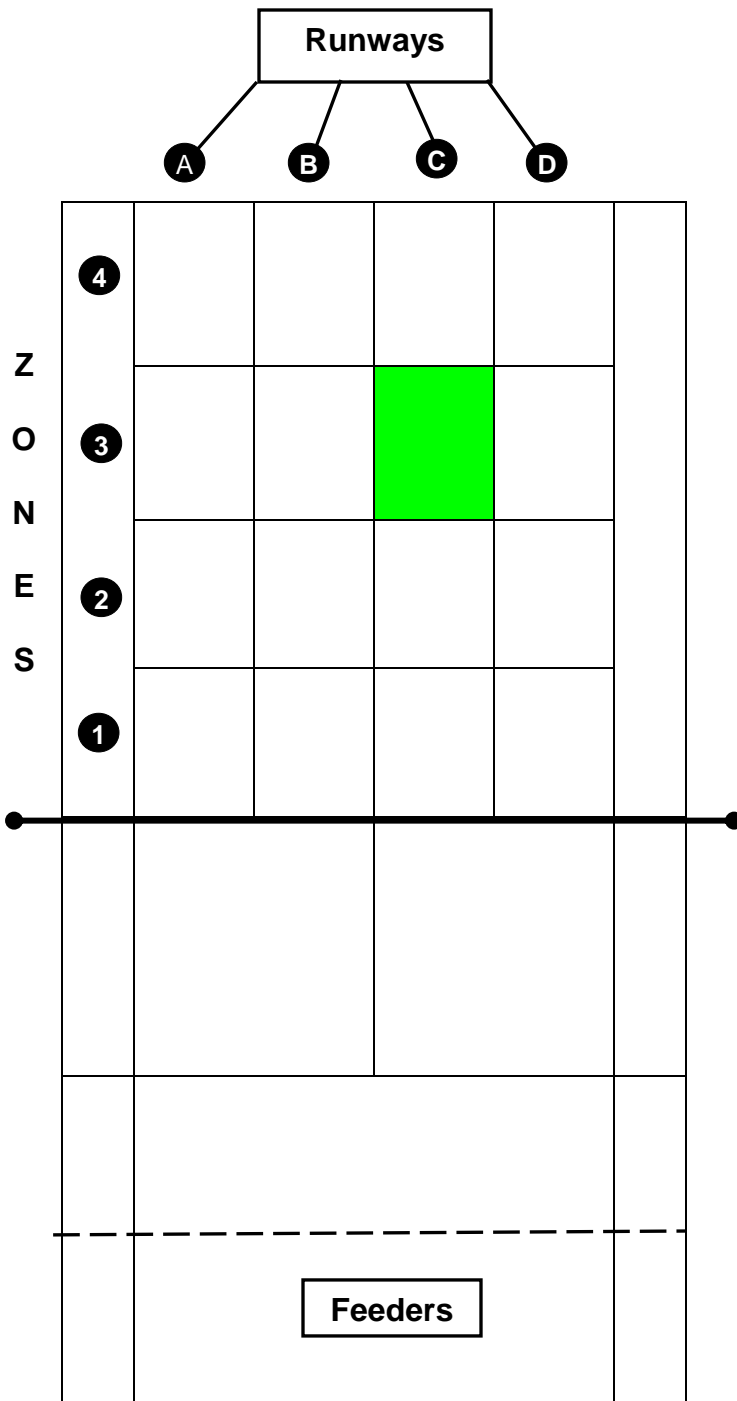


Feeding Contest – Zones and Runways



Rules

This feeding contest is more of a head-to-head competition between 2 feeders.

The court is divided up into 16 smaller target areas based on the Zones and Runways of the court.

The target area that is lit up in the diagram is **Zone 3, Runway C**.

- 1) The contest uses the HORSE game from basketball.
- 2) The first feeder calls out one of the 16 possible areas and tries to feed a ball into that area. If he makes it, the next feeder must match that or he gets the letter H.
- 3) If the original feeder misses the target, the next feeder has an open court and gets to call out a new target area.
- 4) Feeders only get letters when they cannot match the previous feed that went in to the correct target. They do not get a letter if they miss a feed on a target area that they called out themselves.
- 5) The first feeder to get all the letters in HORSE loses the game.
